## Monthyy Book Report

Each month students are required to complete a book report form on a book the student read that month. I would ask that parents read with their child and help them throughout the process. The main goal of this assignment is for practicing strategies learned in class and to develop a love of reading in the student.
Reports are due on the last school day of the month but may be turned in at any time throughout the month. Book report forms can be found on our class page to be printed out. Hard copies are available from Mrs. King upon request.

## Guidelines

1. Read any book that is a second grade reading level or higher.

It is ok to sometimes read a book that is easy reading, but try to read challenging books too. If you cannot read 5 words on a page, the book is too difficult. *THINK Good Fit Books
2. Choose a Book Report Form and print it out. Each Report should be 2 pages. Please try to complete a different form each month; the forms are single pages so that you can create different combinations to give you 2 pages (each form shouldn't be used more than twice).
3. Complete the report. Each section of the form should be filled in using complete sentences and all questions should be answered.
4. Hand the report in. Forms are due the last day of the month or earlier. Late reports will be marked down.
